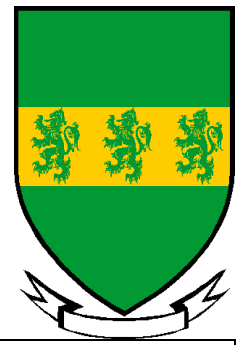




The Madrigal Dinner
